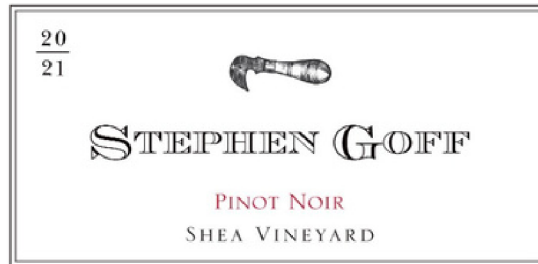

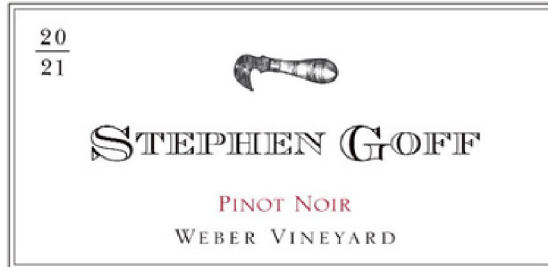
Picked on September 16th, the fruit was 100% de-stemmed and fermented in small 1.5/ton vessels. The wine spent a total of 21 days on skins before being pressed directly to barrel without settling. Once in barrel the wine spent 11-months resting on its lees in 33% New, 33% 1-year old and 33% 2-year old French oak barrels. Bottled December 2022.

### Vineyards

Located in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA of the Northern Willamette Valley, Shea Vineyard is regarded as one of the best and most sought-after Pinot Noir vineyards in all of Oregon. Encompassing over 140 planted acres the fruit for our wine comes from a 1.57 acre portion of block 25. Located on the far western edge of Shea's west hill at an elevation of 500 feet. ### Vineyards

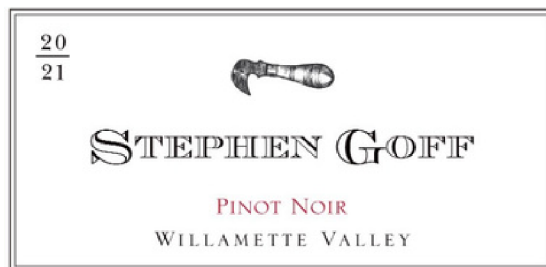
Located in the heart of the Dundee Hills AVA of the Northern Willamette Valley, Weber Vineyard is one of the oldest own-rooted plantings remaining in the valley. Sourcing from the top of block 8, this 1.1 acre parcel of 36yr old own-rooted Pommard clone Pinot Noir sits at 425ft of elevation in a deep volcanic Jory soil.

Picked on September 16th and 26th, the fruit was 100% de-stemmed and fermented in small 1.5/ton vessels. The wine spent a total of 19-21 days on skins before being pressed directly to barrel without settling. Once in barrel the wine spent 11-months resting on its lees in approximately 25% New 30% 1yr and 45% 2yr old barrels. Bottled December 2022.

### Vineyards

A blend of both the Shea and Weber Vineyards aged 11-months in a mix of New, one and two year old French oak. While inherently different vineyard sites these two marquee properties have proven over and over that they blend remarkably well together. You will be hard pressed to find vineyards of this pedigree in a wine at this price point!



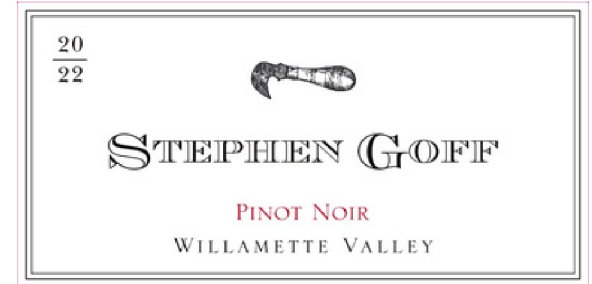

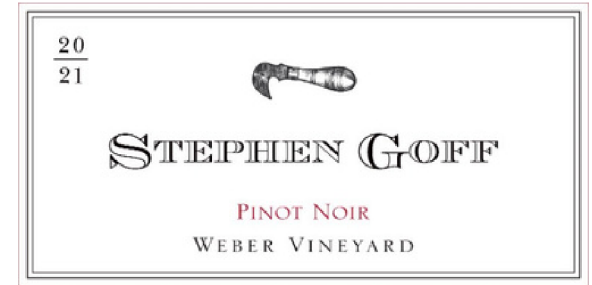
